

Instructions for Adjustable Deadbolts

Adjustable dead bolts are set to a 2-3/8" backset by default at the factory.

To change to a 2-3/4" backset, simply do the following:

1. Locate the throw pin. It is the small bar that sticks out on each side of the dead bolt. It is located below the words "US Patent".
2. Push the throw pin upwards towards the top of dead bolt. This will release the movable part inside.
3. Grasp the flat metal band on the lower right edge of the dead bolt and pull it to the right, away from the throw pin. This will move the sliding part. Move it until the spindle slot (the rectangular hole) lines up with the 2-3/4" hole.
